Thumb piano - 'Mbira, Kalimba, Likembe (Congo), Sanza (East Africa)

'Mbira, the original instrument uses microtonal scales. Hugh Tracey, a British musicologist, simplified the instrument and westernized the scale to a 12 tone diatonic/chromatic scale, and this became what is called Kalimba.
