
One Girl At A Time

The Global Village Project is a school for refugee girls located right in the heart of Georgia,
Decatur. The school started from a need noticed by the community in Clarkston. Refugee girls were missing years of school in the transition from their home country to the US and even then there was commonly a lack of knowledge of the English language which made public school a difficult endeavor. Thus the Global Village Project started as the efforts of a group of volunteers to bridge the gap in understanding while allowing the girls a safe and respectful space to embrace their differences.
